

Our Expectations From Students

- Get ready in time so that you can arrive school 5 minutes prior the warning bell. Don't be late.
- 2. Put on a neat & ironed school uniform daily without fail. Polish your shoes on your own before you put it on.

- Don't forget to carry your school diary to school. No extra book to be brought in school other the school books.
- 5. At the time of the 1st bell, you must come out of your classroom & assemble in ground for the morning prayer. It is must to attend assembly without any excuse. Always walk along the left side of the corridors with hands at the back.
- 6. You should not come out without the class out pass. If it's so then you shall not be permitted to attend the lecture of that particular period. No one is allowed to come out of their class during the lecture in progress.
- 7. Be careful to keep your classroom as well as school premises neat & clean. You should not scribble anything on the wall or furniture of the classroom or school.
- 8. You are required to converse only in English in the school premises.
- 9. Your cycle must be locked & kept on the cycle stand in a row. School will not be responsible for any damage or loss of it.
- 10. You must greet your teachers whenever you meet them.
- 11. You are not allowed to step in the reception area or use the school telephone without permission.
- You cannot avail any leave during the Class test/Unit test or Term test. No retest will be conducted prior or post.
- 13. Whenever your telephone number/address is changed. Do inform your class teacher immediately with an application. Make the changes in the school diary also.
- 14. Submit a leave application for a casual leave up to 2 days or more. If it is due to medical reason then submit a medical certificate too along with application.

Submit medical certificate for period of such absence on account of sickness,



General Rules

Attendance:

Your ward must be regular and punctual in the school

- It is compulsory for your ward to complete minimum 75% of attendance during the session.
- II.) Early departure will not be allowed under any circumstances. If your ward has some urgent piece of work, please do not send him/her to school.
- III.) Application is must even if your ward has taken one day's leave. Otherwise he/she shall not be allowed to attend the classes.
- IV.) In case of medical leave, medical certificate is to be submitted in school.
- V.) Late comers will be marked absent in the attendance register.

Admission and withdrawal process:

- 1) Once the admission of your ward is done the fee will not be refunded.
- 2) At the time of admission the following documents must be submitted:
 - a) Official birth certificate
 - b) 2 Passport size coloured photographs
 - c) Attested Photocopy of previous year's report card
 - d) Proof of Residential Address
 - e) Transfer Certificate of previous school issued from Rajasthan Govt. Portal
 - f) Copy of Aadhar Card (Candidate, Father, Mother)
 - g) Copy of Caste Certificate for entry of Category SC/ST/OBC
 - h) PEN Number of student.
 - I) APAAR ID of student
- For getting transfer certificate (T.C.) from the school, submit T.C. withdrawal form duly filled a week in advance and clear all school dues to facilitate issuance of T.C. in time.
- 4) Rs. 100/-has to be paid for the issuance of T.C. from the school.

General Rules

Conveyance Facility::

- Conveyance Form must be filled before availing bus/van facility. It cannot be
 withdrawn in the middle of the session. A month prior information should be given
 in writing regarding withdrawal from availing conveyance facility. Conveyance Fee
 is not refundable.
- The school has engaged a Conveyance Contractor and is running a transport network which like any other public transport, would have its constraints.
- All the students using the school bus/van are expected to be ready at least five minutes before the expected time to the arrival of the bus/van.
- Adherence to pickup and drop down points is of paramount importance as it saves time for all.
- Personally seeing your child off in the bus/van and assisting her/him in crossing the road is advisable.
- The bus/van driver has been briefed with regard to the conduct and care of the children in the bus/van.
- The bus/van driver has to reach school on time and so he will not be able to wait beyond the prescribed pick up time.
- Please be patient as the bus/van driver is dealing with many children and various road conditions.
- For bus/van complaints, please give a written complaint to transport in-charge and a copy to the Principal.


